The **UNPACKING DINING ROOM** is a monolithic, continuous entity inspired by Hans Olsen's 1950s dining set. When the chairs are in place, they nestle perfectly into the perimeter, forming a solid volume. Once unfolded, the continuous lines of the backrests and circular leather seats reveal a dynamic setting for six, transitioning the piece from a quiet block to an active space.
